

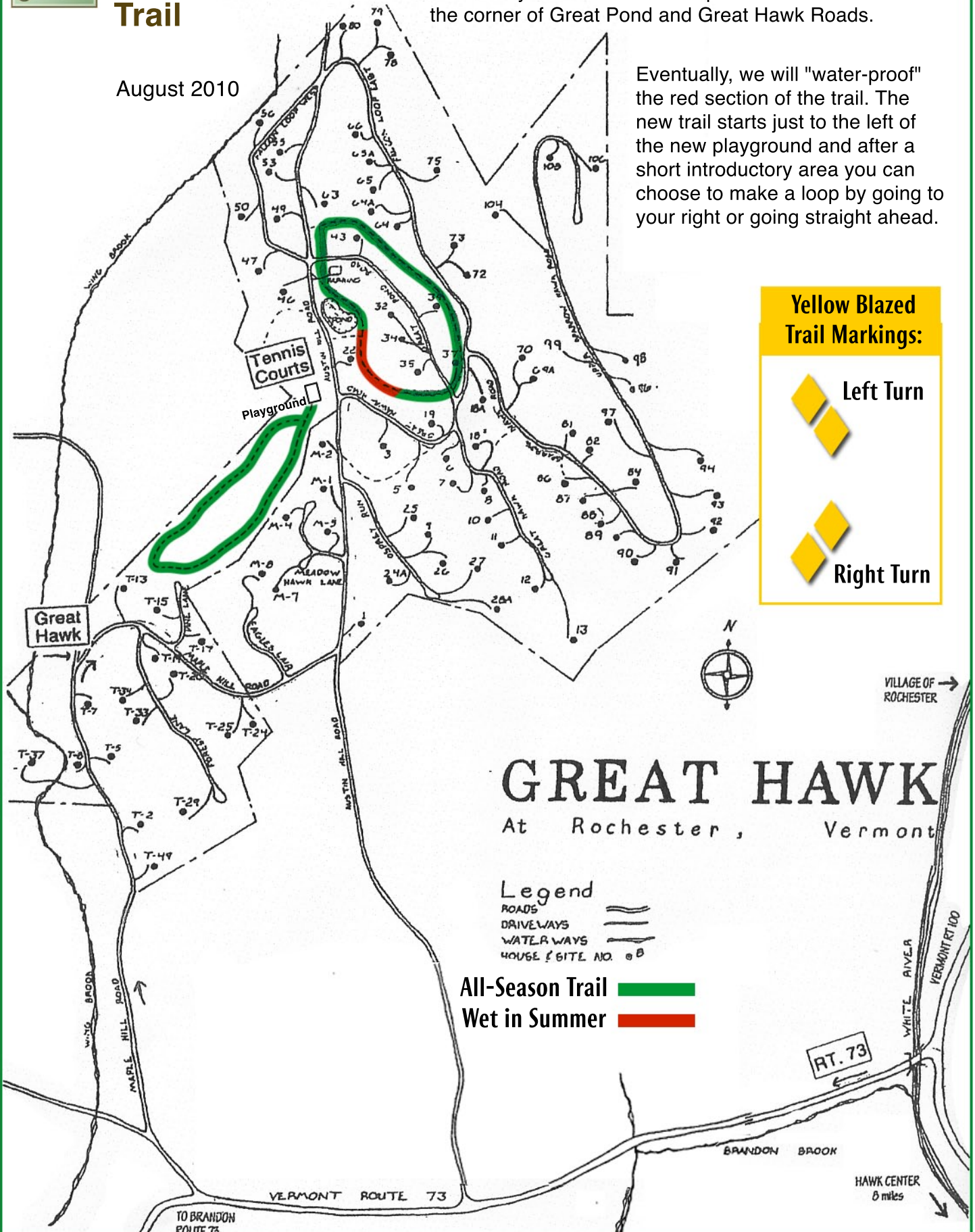


GHOA Hiking, Snowshoeing, X-Country Skiing Trail

August 2010

Great Hawk now has two hiking trails that double as wonderful snowshoeing trails! The areas on the map that are highlighted in green are all-season trails. The area highlighted in red may be wet during the summer and hikers may want to start at the pond and exit the trail in the corner of Great Pond and Great Hawk Roads.

Eventually, we will "water-proof" the red section of the trail. The new trail starts just to the left of the new playground and after a short introductory area you can choose to make a loop by going to your right or going straight ahead.
